**Upcoming:**

**2026 Columbiaville Farmers Market Schedule:** To be a vendor stop by the Village Office and fill out an application, vendor fee is \$10 per day or \$110.00 for the whole season.



**Reminders:**

**\*2026 Tornado Siren Testing:** Testing will be the first Saturday every month from April 5<sup>th</sup> until October 4<sup>th</sup> at 1pm. The siren will sound for a straight 3 minutes without stopping. Should inclement weather be present at the time of testing, the test will be cancelled.

**\*Burn Permits:** If you live within the Village limits ONLY you are not required to have a burn permit, you may have a small bonfire (of brush and wood only) anytime, unless there is a burn ban set.

**\*Leaf Burning:** Per Leaf Burning Ordinance: You may no longer burn Leaves/ grass clippings within the Village limits until October and November.

**\*Blight Ordinance Enforcement and Noxious Weed Ordinance:** The Village of Columbiaville is required by local Ordinance to send notices to any resident that has blight or tall grass located on their property. A notice has be placed in the local newspaper and anyone in violation will be sent a notice with a deadline date for mowing or clean up.
